NABET-CWA/BRONXNET NEGOTIATIONS

The NABET-CWA Local 11 BronxNet Negotiating Committee has reached an overall tentative agreement with BronxNet on a new contract to replace the collective bargaining agreement which expired on September 24, 2018. This contract package is the result of several bargaining sessions which took place at Local 11's offices over the past several months. The package has the recommendation of the Union's Bargaining Committee.

The new contract, if ratified by the membership, will cover all Local 11 members at BronxNet. The contract would run through October 1, 2022.

The tentative agreement contains economic and other improvements to your terms and conditions and employment. The general wage increases total 13% over the next three years (5% upon ratification; 3% on 6/1/2020, 3% on 6/1/2021, and 2% on 6/1/2022) and becomes effective on the first full pay period following ratification. Additionally, the Company has agreed to conduct safety meetings with the Union to address workplace safety and excessive workload issues.

Local 11 will be conducting a ratification vote over the next few weeks. The Local will also be conducting membership meetings and providing further information on this contract package during the ratification process. We thank you for your solidarity and support during the negotiation process.
