Your NABET-CWA Bargaining Committee has been conducting a series of caucus conference calls to evaluate the status of bargaining the NBCSN agreement as well as the COVID-19 issues that are impacting all our members involved in NASCAR.

In the opinion of the membership and your Bargaining Committee, management's communication regarding COVID-related travel policies and restrictions has been extremely poor.

The Bargaining Committee and the Union have been vigilant in demanding a clear and concise policy for travel, especially in relation to travel to and from COVID "hotspots". We fully intend to pursue this issue and get the answers we need so our members can make informed decisions on travel and work that are based on fact. We all understand that things are subject to change. With that being said, we passionately believe the Company needs to timely inform us and the NASCAR membership about the Company's intentions and continue to work on clear policies, even if they change along the way. Communication with the crew and the Union is imperative.

Your Committee would also suggest that prior to your next NASCAR car and travel assignment, you ask all questions you have regarding travel and potential quarantine issues.

We are in discussions with the Company on firming up dates to continue negotiation via Zoom or teleconference.
