NABET-CWA/NBC NASCAR NEGOTIATIONS BULLETIN #3

NABET-CWA opened formal face-to-face negotiations for a new collective bargaining agreement with NBCSN for NASCAR productions. The parties met at NBCUniversal's headquarters at 30 Rock on October 24th, 2019 in New York City.

Representatives of bargaining committees for both parties met to establish ground rules for the negotiations and to exchange initial contract proposal packages.

The Union is represented by NABET-CWA Sector Vice President and Local 11 President Lou Marinaro, Local 11 General Counsel Max Sicherman, Local 31 Vice President Bantu Opiotennione, and Shop Stewards John Duffy and Dean Kamienski.

The Union's bargaining committee emphasized the importance of achieving a fair deal in a timely fashion that addresses the unique concerns of members working NASCAR races. The Union demanded a contract that reflects the contributions NABET-CWA members make to the Company's numerous achievements and successes.

The Union's package is designed to improve working conditions for our members. Our proposals are aimed at addressing wages, travel, meal, safety and quality of life issues.

The parties are scheduled to conduct the next round of negotiations in New York City on November 19th, 2019. During the interim the Union's bargaining committee will continue its work in caucus and the lines of communication with the Company remain open.
