Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Yesterday, your NABET-CWA Bargaining Committee met via video conferencing with company representatives to continue negotiations for a successor agreement to the 2016-2019 Collective Bargaining Agreement with River Operating Company.

While progress has been made in some areas such as increases in medical benefit payments, enacting a continuous service bonus payment, and a 401k Plan, the parties remain apart on proposed changes to scheduling/cancellations and wages (including retroactive pay).

With an eye towards reaching a fair and full successor agreement in a timely manner, the Union continues to put forward reasonable proposals in these areas. The parties are in the process of scheduling additional dates for bargaining in September. We will keep you updated on any developments.

Sisters and Brothers, while negotiating a contract during this pandemic has introduced several uncertainties and problems, your Bargaining Committee is committed to the process, and we greatly appreciate your solidarity and patience.
