TO: All NABET-CWA Local 11 Members

Dear Members:

Nominating petitions for candidates to be delegates to the 2023 NABET-CWA Sector Conference will be available at the Local 11 office, 49 West 37th Street, 16th Floor as of Friday, March 31, 2023. They are available via mail, email or in person. The Conference will be held in St. Louis, Missouri from Thursday, July 6th through Saturday, July 8th, 2023.

In accordance with Article II, Section 2.6(b) of the Local 11 By-Laws, to be eligible to run for delegate, a member must be active continuously in good standing in the Union for no less than one (1) year at the time of their nomination.

At the 2019 NABET-CWA Sector Conference and CWA Convention, up to 4 delegates plus 1 alternate was elected. We are still awaiting notice from the CWA and Sector's office as to how many delegates can be elected for this 2023 Conference.

Petitions must contain signatures (and printed names) of not less than twenty (20) active members in good standing in the Local as of the date petitions are due. These original petitions, along with an optional brief biography (Section 7.3(C) of the Local By-Laws), must be in the Union Office no later than 4:00 PM, Friday, April 28, 2023.

Article VII, Section 7.3(C), Biographical Sketch, reads: *A candidate may submit a biographical sketch which, subject to the rules below, will be mailed with the ballot (see Art 7.9e). Such biographical sketch must be submitted to the Union office prior to 4:00PM on the day that is forty-two (42) days prior to the due date. Such biographical sketch is limited to a single 8 ½ by 11 sheet, one side and is subject to the following rules for inclusion with the ballot: The biographical sketch is not a medium for debate as there is no opportunity for rebuttal. Consequently,*

candidates must limit all opinions and statements contained in the biographical sketch to themselves. Candidates will not refer to other members or former members by name or in any other way. Biographical sketches may not contain statements that endorse or oppose the candidacy of any other candidate or prospective candidate. Any sketch not conforming to these rules will be rejected by the election committee and returned to the candidate who submitted it for revision, with the reason for its return stated. Such revision shall not change or extend the sketch submission date as stated above. Should a candidate supply either an original or a revised sketch after the submission date it will not be mailed with the ballot or distributed to the membership by the Local in any other way.

The election will be by secret ballot, conducted by the NABET-CWA Local 11 Election Committee.
